#### Part A-Field Assessment

#### **Section I- Total Station Surveying**

- 1.1. Set up Total Station. Demonstrate instrumental setting and operation to invigilator. (2 marks)
- 1.2. Check the reliability of control point. Use independent station for quality check. Show check station in your cadastral dataset. (2 marks)
- 1.3. *Traverse*: Run travers from the known control points (**10 marks**)
  - Provide at least 3 traverse points. Measure in both faces.
  - Adjust traverse.
  - Check the quality of the traverse.

## 1.4. **Cadastral Surveying:**

#### 1. Boundary demarcation (5 marks)

Demarcate corners of the boundary using the given coordinates.

#### 2. Surveying (5 marks)

• Survey the structure and ground features inside and nearby the surveyed boundary.

#### 1.5. Map preparation (10 marks)

You must show all critical map elements and thram information on your map. Make 2 color printouts for assessment by the invigilators. Don't forget to write your index number.
